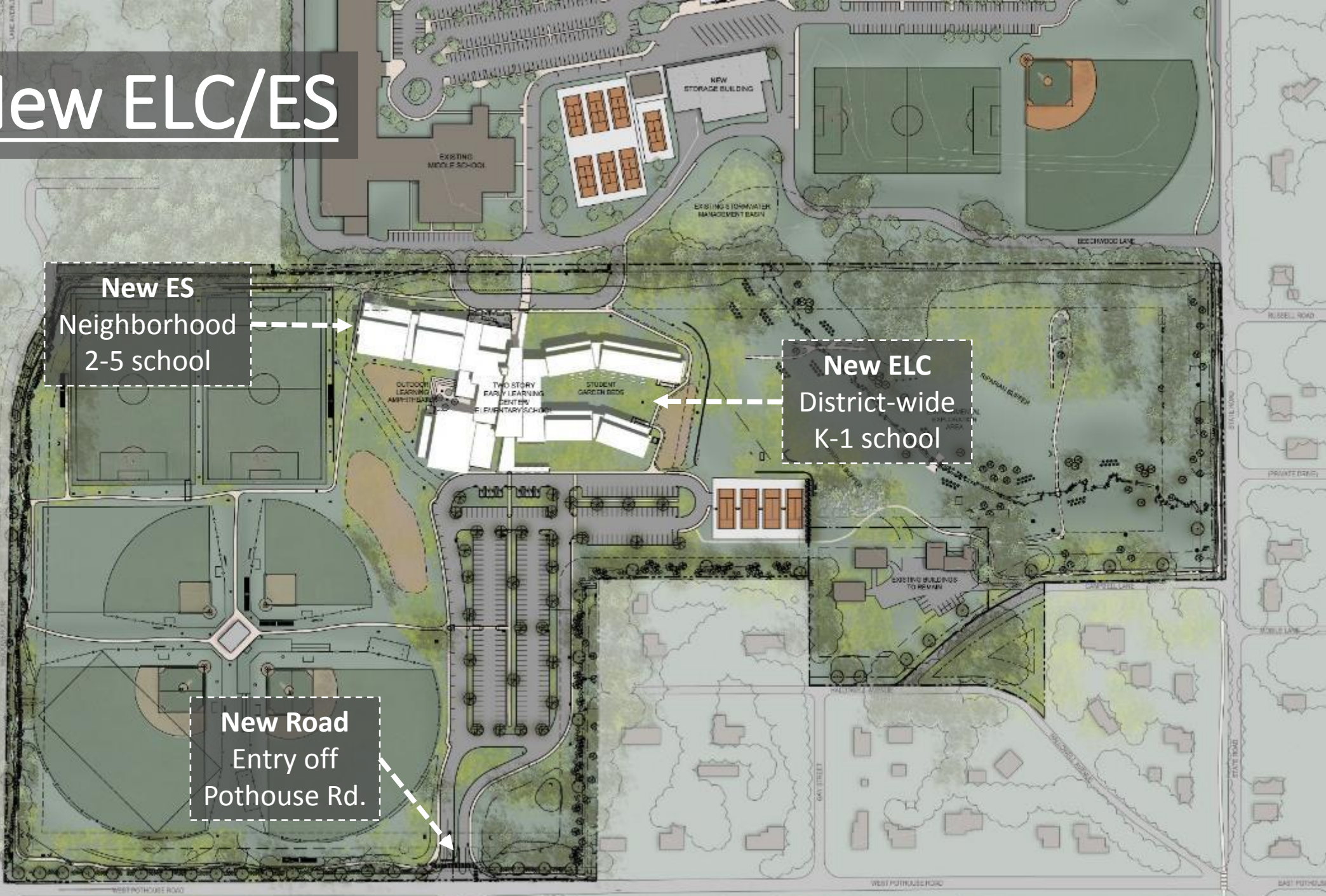

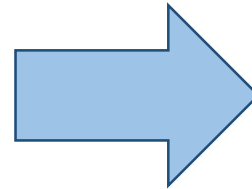

Proposed Redistricting Parameters

- Maximize students who can walk to school (i.e., “walkers”)
- Assign East Pikeland residents to the New ELC/ES
- Minimize households affected by new attendance zones
- Minimize transportation deviations or exceptions
- Manage transportation complexity

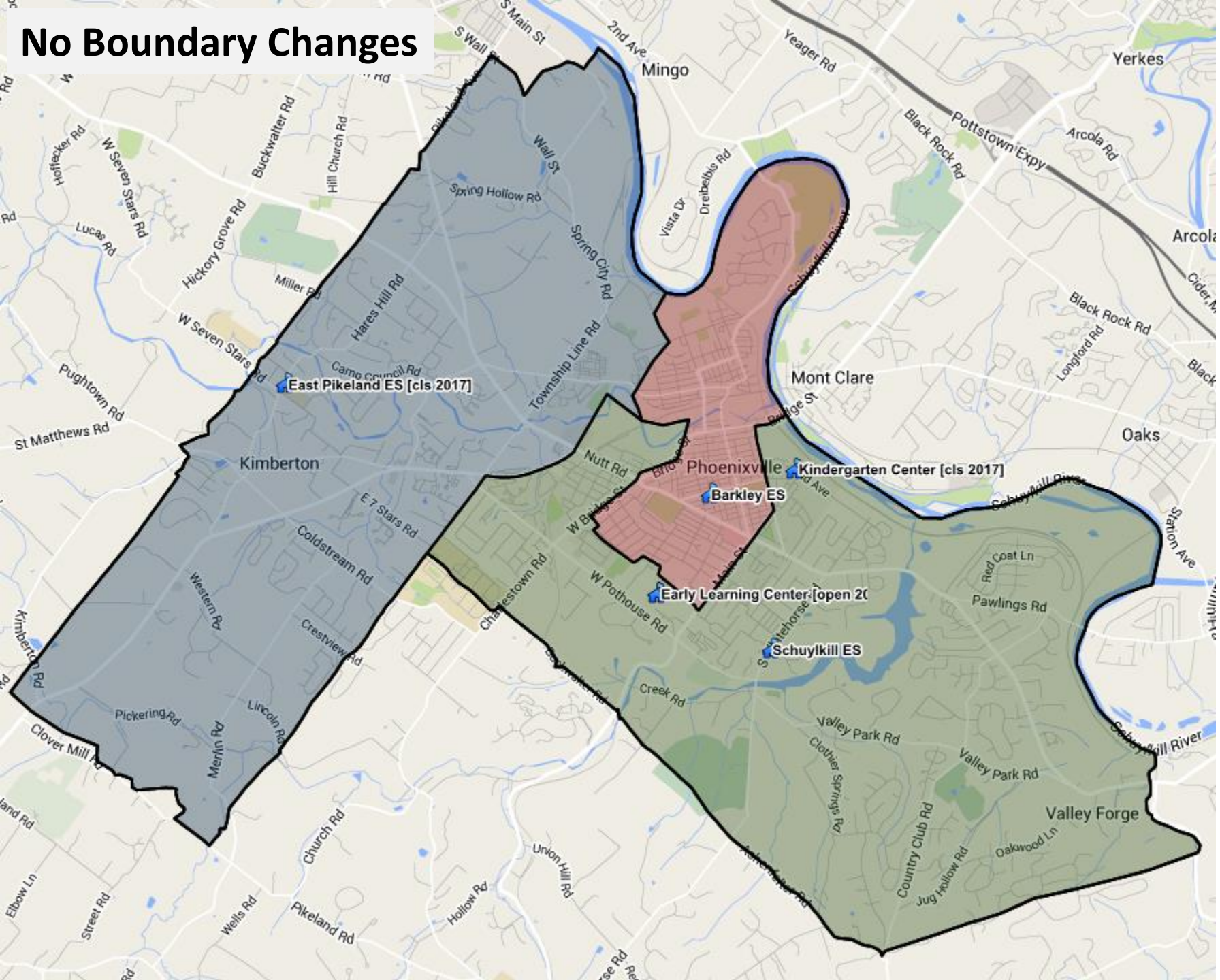


Fall 2017

No Boundary Changes

- Grade configurations changed
- Current attendance zones remain unchanged

Target Range for Capacity Utilization → 80 – 85%



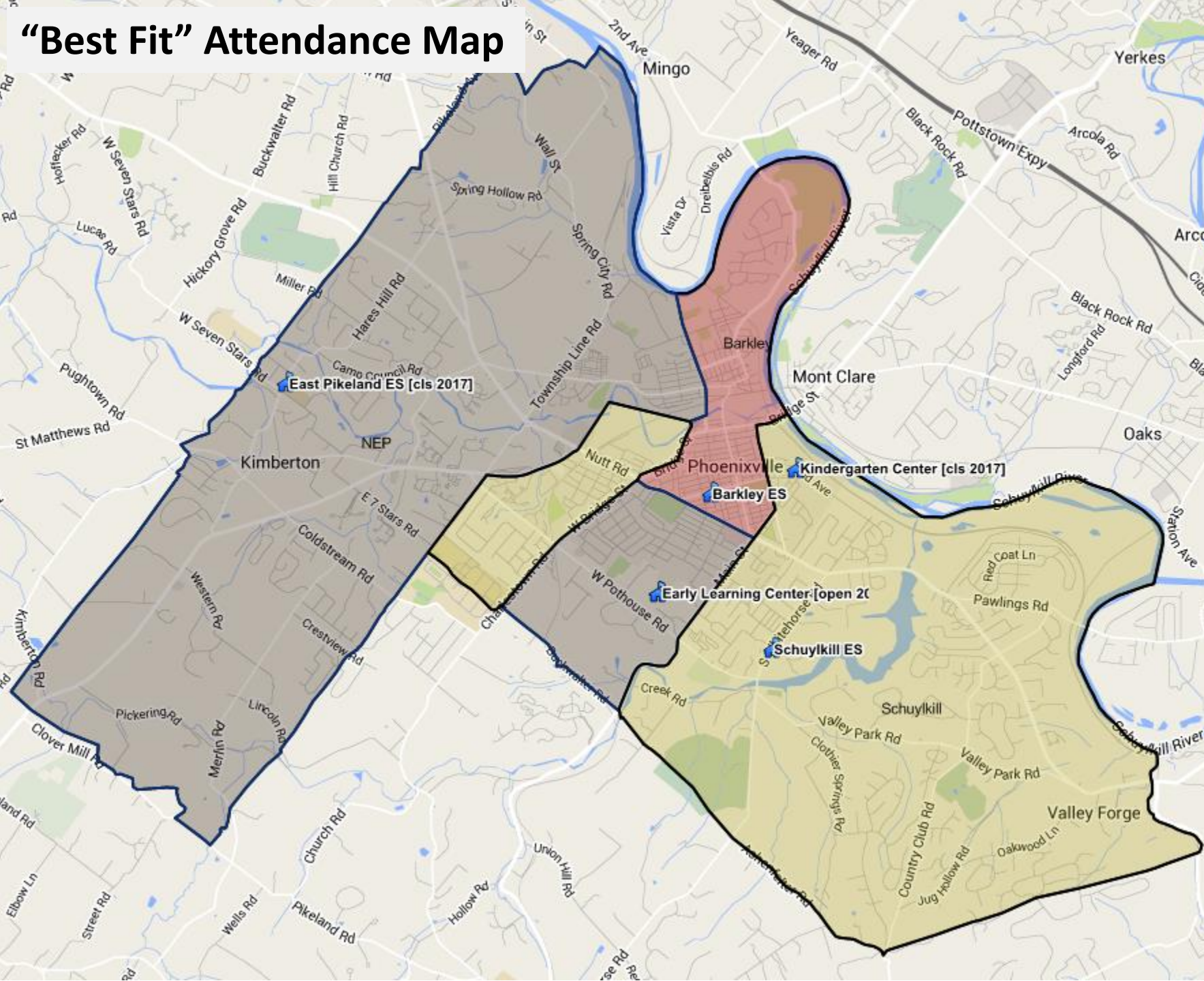

Fall 2017

“Best Fit” Attendance Map

- Grade configurations changed
- Portions of Barkley and Schuylkill attendance zones added to New ES
- Non-contiguous portion remains with Schuylkill



Target Range for Capacity Utilization → 80 – 85%

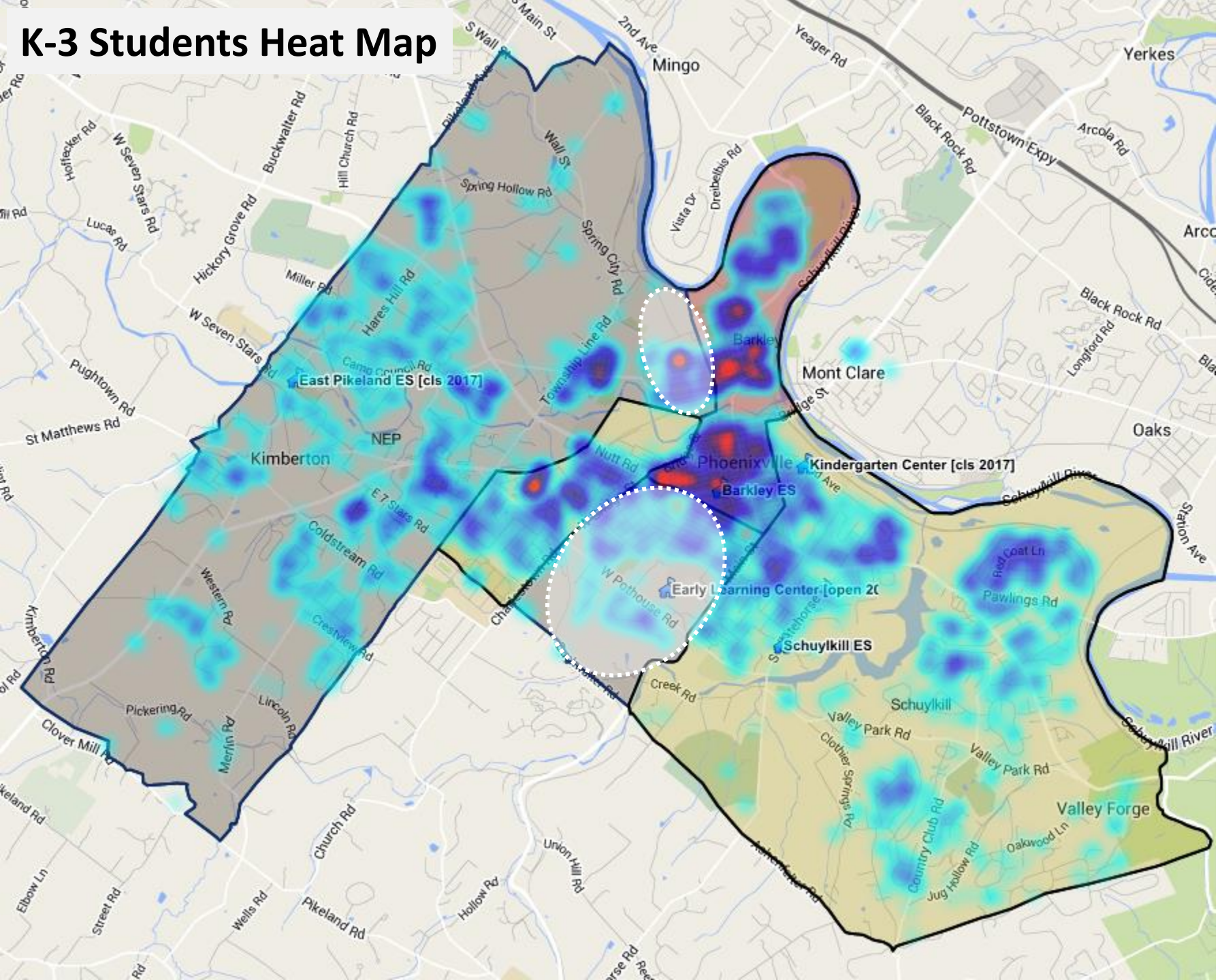

Implementation Considerations

- For Fall 2017, should we “grandfather” rising 5th graders who would be otherwise rezoned to another school?
- For Fall 2016, should we allow rising 1st graders who will be rezoned to another school in Fall 2017 to join new school a year early?



K-3 Students Heat Map



Notes:

- Current K-3 students will be Grade 2-5 students in Fall 2017
- Approx. **150** Grade 2-5 students would be rezoned to another school by redistricting in Fall 2017
- Of that group, **43** would be rising 5th graders in Fall 2017...
- While **38** would be rising 1st graders in Fall 2016

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- For Fall 2016, should we allow rising 1st graders who will be rezoned to another school in Fall 2017 to join new school a year early?

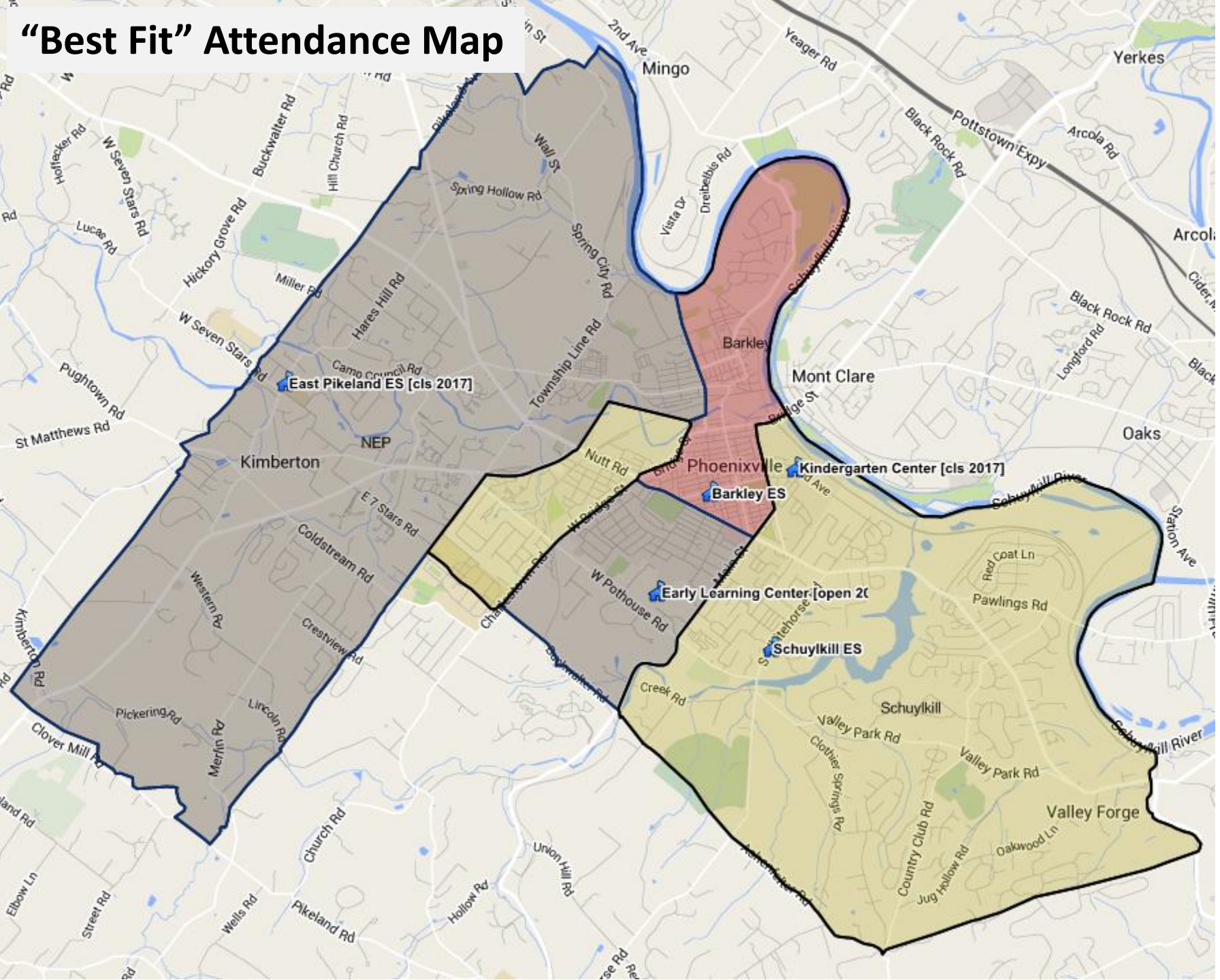
